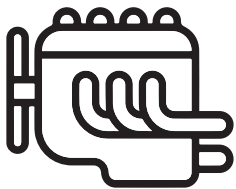

## OILS & GREASE

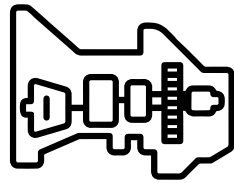

### SOME TYPES OF LUBRICANTS:



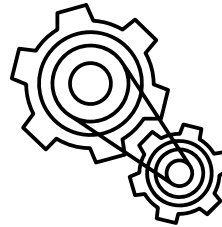
#### ENGINE OILS

Lubricates internal combustion engines



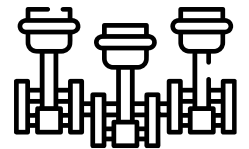
#### TRANSMISSION FLUIDS

Lubricants moving parts on cars and other machines

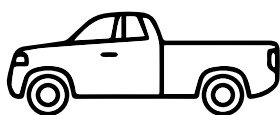
### WHY USE LUBRICANTS:

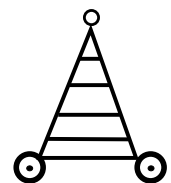
