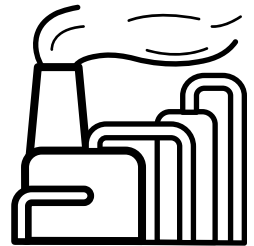

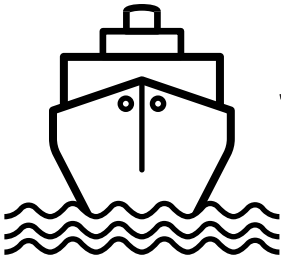
When crude oil is extracted, it is transported to a refinery, or an industrial factory, to be processed. Once processing is complete, the gasoline and other products are shipped to various terminals across the United States by rail, trucks, and underground pipelines. Once the fuel is received at the terminals, it can be purchased by truck stops, gas stations, and fuel suppliers such as a co-op to then be resold to end-users or customers. 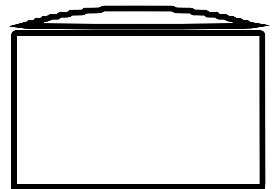
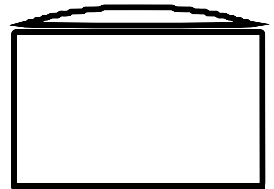
DOMESTIC OIL



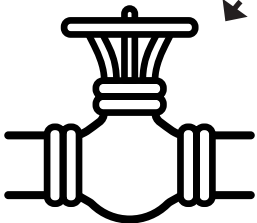
REFINERY



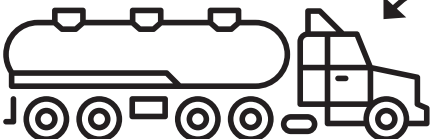
IMPORTED OIL
